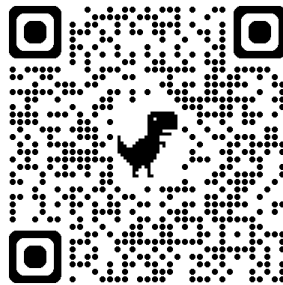


PROJECT PLAYHOUSE

Frequently Asked Questions

Should we bring tools?

Every group will have their own kit of tools that they will need to build the playhouse. These kits include such items as impact drivers, batteries, hammers, levels, etc. You are welcome to bring extra tools, but it is not necessary.

May we wear our company organization shirts?

Yes! You are encouraged to represent your organization proudly.

What can we expect on the build day?

The event agenda will include registration, a safety huddle, the building phase, lunch, and then the playhouse reveal.

Will we get dirty?

Definitely. Dress comfortable - wear something you wouldn't mind getting messy or damaged. No open-toed shoes are permitted.

What if it rains on the day of our build?

The event and all playhouses will be built in covered areas.
